Dates for birds are first date seen. Wild birds only. If seen at several places first place may be listed. Common means seen in any suitable habitat. ? means uncertain or quick sighting usually from car. New birds for us in Australia: 2004 - blue; 2007 Red; 2010 Green. At Cairns esplanade there were a lot of waders we could not identify. Also sea birds seen off Redhead Bay were too far out to identify. N. T. =Northern Territory. Some tips: Bottlebrush bushes are always worth a look for birds and butterflies; botanic gardens usually very good. If you can only visit one place Cairns and Tablelands in September/October will let you see the most species. Feel free to get in touch with Margaret and John for more details of accommodation etc. We rent cabins in Tourist Parks as you see a lot more wildlife that way. Cania Gorge- We usually stay in the Big 4 accommodation at the end nearest Dam, access to river on site, 2010 best place for butterflies. Best place we have found for Platypus is Broken River tourist park Eungella in their Spring, ponds very near. It is better to book these places in advance, also accommodation in Rockhampton (they have regular bull-sales) Abberton Birding Lodge –see website for good pictures of birds
